


# 2022 The Best of ISRAEL AND MEDITERRANEAN

## ITINERARY

October 23 - November 8, 2022

### October 23 – Depart São Paulo and New York

#### October 24 – Arrive in Tel Aviv

Arrive in Tel Aviv, where you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel in Netanya. Enjoy dinner and rest at your hotel in Tel Aviv.

#### October 25 – Caesarea, & Joppa

Visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of early Christianity (Acts 10) and where Paul was imprisoned for two years (Acts 23:33). Visit the ancient port city of Jaffa (Joppa) from where Jonah tried to flee from his appointed mission and Solomon brought the Cedars of Lebanon. Joppa was the place of the miracle of the resurrection of Tabitha (Acts 9:36–43) and the house of Simon the Tanner, on whose roof Peter had a vision that changed the face of Christendom (Acts 10:9–16). Check into your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and rest.

#### October 26 - Sea of Galilee

Worship as you sail across the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in Galilee, and visit the synagogue built on the site where Jesus taught (Matthew 4:13, 23). On the Mount of Beatitudes, contemplate the "Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 5-7). Explore the Church of the Loaves and Fish at Tabgha, the traditional site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10-17). See the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter professed his devotion three times to the risen Christ (John 21). In Magdala, once home to Mary Magdalene, visit a recently discovered first-century synagogue. Recall Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist at the Jordan River. Enjoy dinner and rest at your hotel in Tiberias.

#### October 27 - Nazareth, Cana, Mount Carmel, Megiddo & Beit Shean

Visit the Franciscan Wedding Chapel in Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle, before continuing on to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23). Continue your journey to Mount Carmel where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Biblically, Mount Carmel is referenced most often as a symbol of beauty and fertility. To be given the "splendor of Carmel" was to be blessed indeed (Isa 35:2). Look out over Tel Megiddo (Armageddon) to view one of the most important archaeological sites in Israel. You will travel to the ruins of Beit Shean, where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls thereafter they were killed in battle (1 Sam. 31: 10,12). Beit Shean is also noted for having the best-preserved ancient Roman theatre in Israel. Also, visit Gideon's Spring (Ein Harod), where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the springs (Jd. 7). Return to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and rest.

#### October 28 - Jericho, Qumran, Masada & Dead Sea

Travel to Jericho (the oldest city in the world) and visit the ruins of the ancient city conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6:1, 2 & 20). In the distance, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4:1-11). Continue to Qumran, the site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery. Enjoy a visit to intriguing Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion

against the Romans. End your day with the opportunity to take a dip in the mineral-laden waters of the Dead Sea. End your day in Jerusalem by checking into your hotel for dinner and rest.

#### October 29 - Bethlehem & Jerusalem

In Bethlehem, visit the cave where Jesus was born (Matthew 1:18-25) and the Church of the Nativity. Gaze out over Shepherds' Field, where angels first proclaimed the Good News. On Mount Zion, visit the Upper Room, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14:12), and St. Peter in Gallicantu, the home of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was held after His arrest (Matt. 26:57). Conditions permitting, walk the Temple Mount. The Southern Wall Excavations of the Temple Mount, including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall, are a must-see. Return to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and rest.

#### October 30 - Jerusalem

Stand on the Mount of Olives as Jesus did, and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Visit both the Church of All Nations and the private garden area across the road for a time of contemplation in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matt. 26:36-44). Continue your journey to view the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle (John 5:1-31). Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne and experience its rich acoustics. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress, where Jesus appeared before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1), and follow in Christ's steps on the Via Dolorosa ("the Way of the Cross"). End the day, experiencing a communion service at the Garden Tomb. Return to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

#### October 31 – Embark on your Cruise

You will be picked up at your hotel in Jerusalem and transferred to the port of Haifa to embark on Royal Caribbean's Rhapsody of the Seas.

#### November 1-7 – Enjoy your cruise on the Rhapsody of the Seas

#### November 8 – Disembark in Barcelona and begin your journey back to São Paulo & New York

### INCLUDED IN THE PRICE:

### ACCOMMODATIONS:

The price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are usually smaller than double rooms. We will try to match roommates, but cannot guarantee that one will be available. Roommates can be assigned up to 35 days prior to departure, and if one is not available or you request a single room, the following single room rates apply: \$998.00 Single rooms are extremely limited and subject to confirmation.

### REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED after July 10, 2022:

We accept registrations after 07/10/22. Registrations received on 7/11/22 or later will be subject to availability and may require additional fees. Additional fees will be advised at the time of registration.

### CANCELLATION FEES:

Those who do not receive travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties per person: From the day of registration until 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged a non-refundable cancellation fee of \$200 plus any airline fees. In addition, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate to stay in a single room plus the following charges per person: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days from departure = 100% of total cost. Send your cancellation in writing. On or after departure, there will be no refund for any unused services.

## LIABILITY STATEMENTS

The agent is not responsible for additional losses or expenses due to airline ticket delays or schedule changes, hotel overbooking, other hotel-related problems or causes, and/or travel supplier cancellations or postponements. Travel suppliers include all tour operators, cruise lines, airlines, hotels, bus companies, entertainment venues, and any other travel supplier used to operate the tour. All such losses or expenses will be the responsibility of the passenger. The agent reserves the right to make adjustments to the itinerary as deemed desirable by the agent, and the agent reserves the right to cancel any tour prior to departure. ### TRAVEL STATEMENT:

Passengers who sign up for the tour accept responsibility to be in good health and to be able to walk and travel on the tour. Many of the sites are not accessible to the physically challenged. Those who need oxygen, wheelchairs, or other ambulatory assistance will find the tour extremely limiting to their experiences. If you have questions, please contact your agent for more details. The agent reserves the right to refuse or revoke the travel of any person who, in the agent's sole discretion, is unable to travel as a group without causing undue demands on the staff or other tour participants. Accessible rooms/cabins are limited and subject to confirmation upon receipt of the passenger's written request.

### PASSPORT INFORMATION AND CHECK IN PROCESS:

Passport information must be submitted to our office no later than 07/10/22. Failure to provide your passport information to our office by this date may result in change fees or refusal of travel. Discrepancies in information may result in change fees, delays in receiving travel documents for your travel, or travel denial. Any fees incurred due to discrepancies are the responsibility of the traveler. You must also check in with the cruise line prior to travel and in accordance with the cruise line's requirements and instructions provided in your final documents.

### PRICE INCREASES:

All prices quoted in this brochure are subject to change prior to full payment due to currency fluctuations, fuel surcharge increases, government tax and duty increases or unforeseen circumstances. In addition, you may be subject to a price increase after full payment has been received due to possible government imposed taxes and duties.

### AIRLINE ROUTES AND TICKETS:

To keep prices low, the agent does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once issued, airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded later. Air transportation to/from your destination will be in economy class on IATA and ARC airlines using non-refundable, non-changeable APEX or SUPER APEX tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together throughout the itinerary. If you choose to depart from a different city than your group or travel companion, or deviate from your flight and/or travel plans and/or are doing a pre- or post-tour, you may fly on a different scheduled flight(s) than the rest of your group. If you make your own air arrangements, you will be responsible for booking all necessary flights for your trip unless otherwise specified. Please contact your agents for details.

### FLIGHT SCHEDULES AND SEATS:

All flights are subject to change by the airlines without notice. The agent is not responsible for such changes or delays and will not reimburse expenses arising from such delays. If you are planning your own flight to the departure city, we recommend that you purchase a ticket that can be changed without major penalties. There is no advance seat selection for groups on most airlines. Advance check-in is required to secure seats with traveling companions and people with special needs. Due to airport security measures, it is advisable to arrive at the airport three hours before departure time. Seats are under the exclusive control of the airlines.

### ADDITIONAL AIRFARES:

You will likely incur additional checked baggage fees from the airline that are not included in the price of the tour. These fees vary by airline and are at the discretion of the airline on each segment of the flight itinerary. If you are in your 24th week or have completed it, you will not be able to board. Due to limited medical facilities, babies must be at least one year old on the first day of the cruise.

### VALIDITY DATE:

This brochure is valid until 12/01/22. If the expiration date has passed, check with your agent on validity. Applications will still be accepted after the expiration date.

### POSTING INFORMATION:

Payment of the deposit indicates permission for the agent or its agents to record the registrant's participation and appearance on videotape, audiotape, film, photograph, or any other medium and to use the registrant's name, likeness, voice, comments, submitted documentation, written papers and/or biographical material without restriction or limitation for any advertising, marketing, publicity, educational or promotional purposes that the agent or its agents deem appropriate unless the registrant or responsible party notifies the agent in writing prior to departure.
